Gift Aid

Making a gift of any size and using the Gift Aid Scheme enables the Taunton School Foundation to reclaim from the Government the basic rate of tax on the gift which will already have been paid by the donor. Donations gain 25p for every £1. Higher rate tax payers can claim higher relief on their donations by including them in the Gift Aid box on their Self-Assessment Tax Return.

Please treat as Gift Aid donations all qualifying gifts of money made today, in the past 4 years and in the future.

I confirm I have paid or will pay an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax for each tax year (6 April to 5 April) that is at least equal to the amount of tax that all the charities or Community Amateur Sports Clubs (CASCs) that I donate to will reclaim on my gifts for that tax year. I understand that other taxes such as VAT and Council Tax do not qualify. I understand that the charity will reclaim 28p of tax on every £1 that I gave up to 5 April 2008 and will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 that I give on or after 6 April 2008.
